Dive Cozumel:



Cozumel is Mexico's largest inhabited island and home to some of the world's best diving. Most divers head straight to Cozumel and set up base-camp here, like we will be doing at the dive resort. With 18 miles of reefs, 200 species of tropical fish and an underwater visibility of over 100 feet, most of the diving here is easy drift diving and beautiful wall diving.

Cenote Dive:

One of Mexico's most famous dive sites is the Cenote cave system. Cenotes are natural pits, or sinkholes, resulting from the collapse of limestone bedrock that exposes groundwater underneath.

Cenotes are classified as open, semi-open, ancient and cavern cenote based on their age.

Cenote comes from the Mayan word "dzonot", which means cave with water. The Mayan's used these crystalline springs, connected by a network of underground rivers as a source of water.



The Cenotes are unique to the Yucatan Peninsula of Mexico. Water temperature is 78 degrees and is a crystal clear turquoise color making for great visibility and a pleasant dive! Plus, the cenotes are one of the only places you can dive in fresh and salt water in one dive!

You will be able to dive between stalactites and stalagmites and explore one of the most famous dive destinations in not only Mexico, but the world.

Whale Shark Snorkel:

Snorkel with the largest fish in the sea - The Whale Shark! The Whale Sharks come to the Yucatan coast where the Gulf of Mexico waters and the waters of the Caribbean Sea merge. This nutrient rich, plankton laden area is where Whale Sharks come to May through August.



This "plankton bloom" provides the environment of Mexico to have the highest concentration of whale sharks in the world.

The Whale Sharks feed at the surface so they can easily be enjoyed while snorkeling. In addition, it is not uncommon to see Bottlenose Dolphins, Manta Rays, turtles and hundreds of flamingos on your snorkel.
